Weatherproof Cushions

HOW WE DEFINE WEATHERPROOF

Dry Lion cushions are designed to be weatherproof, this means that they can be left out in all weathers and won't fade (in direct sunlight) or rot in damp and humid conditions. Yes, heavy rainfall will make the cushions wet and the water will penetrate to some degree, but the nature of the materials we use to manufacture our cushions means that they will dry out - very quickly in the Spring/Summer sunshine - and be ready for use again in no time.

Often, cushions claiming to be "water or shower proof" are manufactured using polyester covers, which do repel rainwater but they also lock in moisture which can then lead to the fibre filling sweating, getting damp and subsequently going mouldy or rotting. Our cushions are designed not to do this.

The cushion covers are made from solution-dyed, Teflon-coated Olefin yarn. They are water and stain repellent and offer optimal UV-resistance and swimming pool water-fastness. The fabric is manufactured 100% in EU and complies with all REACH regulations. It is an eco-friendly fabric which can be recycled with other plastics at the end of its life.

The filling is made of light-weight, compressed polyester fibre manufactured from discarded plastic bottles which is free-draining, rot-proof, odour-resistant and non-allergenic.

General Cleaning Instructions

When spillages occur, use a damp cloth to wipe away the excess. Rinse the cloth and repeat until the liquid has been completely removed. Sometimes, with particularly colourful liquids (EG red wine) we find that a final dabbing with a clean, damp sponge may produce the best result. Detergents can be used for more stubborn stains. Dust and general airborne particles will gather naturally after a while, especially during windy weather or lengthy dry periods. We advise using a hand held vacuum cleaner or brush with soft bristles to remove this.



The covers are also machine washable although we do not advise that you remove the fibre filling of our Luxury cushions if you can possibly avoid it. Surface cleaning is usually all that is required. In very wet weather mould may develop on the cover, you can use a bleach solution to remove this, the fabric will not be damaged. Note: If the mould growth is particularly bad, remove the cover and soak overnight in a fairly strong bleach solution.

In particularly wet weather it is advisable to stand the cushions upright to ensure good water run off, the covers will dry quickly in the sun. If rainwater pools leave a ring mark then it is advisable to wipe these away with a damp cloth or sponge as soon as possible. When cushions are used in areas where there is no natural drainage off the furniture, EG. Rendered brickwork, it is advisable after heavy rain to stand the cushions upright to allow any stagnant water to dry.

IMPORTANT

Please note that our scatter cushions are not guaranteed weatherproof. The filling will get wet in the rain and need to be dried out. It is therefore advisable to bring scatter cushions indoors in wet weather and during the winter months. Also please note that our scatter cushions are designed specifically for use outdoors and are not fire-rated for indoors.



IMPORTANT NOTICE



Dry Lion Cushions are designed specifically for permanent outdoor use only and are not fire-rated for use or storage indoors.

Caution is advised if cushions are to be positioned close to exterior open fires, for example fire pits and BBQ's. Storage indoors is at owner's own risk.
